**ORDER GRANTING DIRECT PURCHASER CLASS PLAINTIFFS’
CIVIL L. R. 7(h) EXPEDITED NON-DISPOSITIVE MOTION
TO SUPPLEMENT CLASS NOTICE**

In consideration of Direct Purchaser Class Plaintiffs’ Civil L.R. 7(h) Expedited Non-Dispositive Motion to Supplement Class Notice, and all submissions related thereto, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that the forms of Notice previously approved in Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Direct Purchaser Plaintiffs’ Settlement with Jui Li Enterprise Company, Ltd. at ¶ 9 (“Preliminary Approval Order”) (ECF No. 1110) are superseded by those attached to the Supplemental Declaration of Carla A. Peak Regarding Notice Plan and Notice Documents at Exhibit 1.

The Court approves these Notices and further finds that the mailing and publication of the Notices as set forth in Preliminary Approval Order (ECF No. 1110) are the best notices practicable under the circumstances; are valid, due and sufficient notice to all settlement and litigation class members; and comply fully with the requirements of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23 and the due process requirements of the Constitution of the United States. The

Court further finds that the forms of Notice are written in plain language, use simple terminology, and are designed to be readily understandable by settlement class members and litigation class members. Notice shall be effectuated in accordance with the Notice Plan set forth in the Preliminary Approval Order (ECF No. 1110).
